Meet Jim Beard

Jim Beard grew up in Grimes County, TX and was a graduate of Navasota High School. From there he attended and graduated from Texas A & M in 1978 with a Bachelor of Business Administration Degree. After trying several occupations, Beard ultimately decided to start his own business in Navasota, TX with State Farm Insurance. He received several accomplishments during his State Farm career- eventually growing his business to one of the most successful in the county.

Your goals & why you chose them.
Sealed copy of transcript (at minimum through end of junior year).
